Age 18+ with 3 years
driving experience

Disaster Action Team Member

Assist individuals and families who have been impacted by a home fire or local other disaster.

Time Commitment: 2 on-call shifts per month, 12 hours each Age 18+ Blood Donor Ambassador

Help save lives in your community by supporting blood collection at a local blood drive.

Time Commitment: 1 shift (4-6 hours) per month

Age 13+ with adult, 14+ without adult supervision
